Opportunity/Challenge

On February 29, 2012 a bank branch in Harrisburg, Illinois was impacted by a tornado. This required replacement of canopy, roof, windows, interior finishes, ceilings and drive-thru equipment. The owner of the facility requested that Hokanson Companies, Inc. have the bank branch back online as soon as possible.

Solution

Hokanson Companies, Inc. (HCI) was on site within hours to assess the damage caused by the tornado, meet with insurance agent and begin the branch restoration process. In addition to the assessment, HCI quickly began site clean-up to ensure the area was safe and clear of debris. HCI immediately met with a structural engineer to investigate the facility structure to confirm it was sound and assessed the steel structure to determine future issues that may arise.
